Man2Man University

A 10 week peer to peer support group that takes place at Café Rhema in Downtown Flint. This group meets to discuss topics from finances, childhood, relationships, hobbies and their children. This focused discussion builds solidarity throughout the group allowing men to be open and vulnerable about their fears, concerns, worries and problems without judgement or backlash.

Leadership Training

An 8-week course designed to build and train leaders through the arts of speech and group facilitation. Each week, men will be given a short lesson and then asked to practice each skill culminating in a polished activity leading the entire cohort in an activity and discussion. Graduates will qualify to be a part of InvolvedDad programming as a facilitator

IMPACT

A fatherhood program that partners with Genesee County Friend of Court and various community agencies to restore paternal relationships and address child support delinquency matters. This 7 month program gives men an opportunity to address their emotional and financial struggles to move them closer to being the dads their families need. Having an involved male presence positively affects all aspects of fragile families including youth assault rates, food insecurity, poverty and even neighborhood safety.

180

180 is designed to combat the significant sociobehavioral factors which fathers who have faced trauma with mental health problems face. Through group and individual counseling sessions InvolvedDad works to uncover and heal their emotional wounds in efforts to break the cycle of recidivism. The results of this healing will allow these men to re-engage with their communities to strengthen neighborhoods and fragile families. 180 is the first step for these men that will ultimately lead to participation in InvolvedDad's suite of programs.
